- Students on F1 visas are permitted to work 20 hours a week on school grounds
- Only F1 students are eligible to apply for optional practical training (OPT) during the semester in which they will finish their programme of study. After each degree, OPT can be used for a maximum of 12 months of full-time jobs

UNITED KINGDOM



- The most popular destination for students
- Education and training in the UK can be very cost-effective
- UK universities provide separate scholarships to Indian students
- Cost-effective- almost all courses are completed in one year
- International students are allowed to work up to 20 hours per week while studying

CANADA



- Canada's largest cities, Vancouver, Toronto, and Montreal have been recognised as world-class places to live and work, and the country is a global pioneer in electronics, telecommunications, aerospace, engineering, urban transportation, biotechnology, mining technology, and environmental industries
- On-campus work is permitted 20 hours per week. Any student who studies for more than 8 months is granted a ONE-YEAR work permit

ITALY

- Internships and industry experience with Versace, Gucci, Armani, Ferrari, and other luxury brands are available
- Students studying in Italy have access to some of the world's most influential art, architecture, and history

AUSTRALIA

- High living standards at low research and living costs. After completing at least two years of study, a student may apply for PR (permanent residency)
- Students are required to work 20 hours per week

GERMANY

- Most public colleges have free tuition and some public universities only charge between 500 and 1500 euros a year
- Students are permitted to work part-time and about 180 half days a year. As a result, the students will work part-time for 18-24 hours per week. Students can also work off-campus

SINGAPORE



- Singapore is a leading educational hub that provides students with a global perspective and a wide range of options
- With its integrated infrastructure, political stability, and open business policies, Singapore is a global business centre
- Public university students and licensed PEOS can work up to 16 hours per week

NEW ZEALAND



- All courses and national qualifications must be approved and registered by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority. All diplomas, undergraduate and graduate programmes offered by New Zealand universities are approved by the New Zealand Vice-Committee Chancellor's.
- Students can work up to 20 hours a week during the school year & can work full-time in summer vacation.
- International students that have completed a course that qualifies them for the Skilled Migrant Category will be eligible for the 1-year work permit.

SWITZERLAND



- Switzerland has a long and illustrious history of success in the field of hospitality education
- The Swiss Hospitality Schools, which offer 6 months of classroom instruction followed by 6 months of industry experience, are the most common educational options for international students
- For the first six months, foreign students are not permitted to work
- They can work 15 hours per week during the academic semester and full time during the holiday breaks after this date

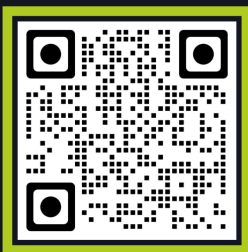

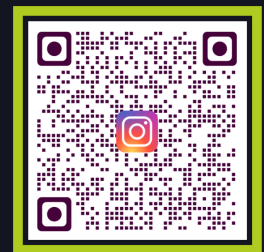
